



## Part names





**External battery case** Alkaline batteries (not included) can be inserted in the external battery case to power the unit. It can also be used to recharge the internal battery (when the TV is off).





DC input terminal (used to connect the AC adapter when recharging the internal battery)

## Introduction


Recharge the battery before using this product. The battery is recharged in approximately 90 minutes.

## Turning the power on and off

To turn the power on, press and hold (for approximately 2 seconds) the TV button on the side of the unit. The power is turned off in the same way.


# Watching the TV

To watch the TV, press and hold the TV button to turn the power on.



## Setting channels: Tuning Mode

After purchasing this product, the channel is set to CH 1 when the power is first turned on.



Channel display (example) **Tuning Mode** 

## 1. Manual tuning

Press the SET button to display the channel you are watching. If either the UP or DOWN button is then pressed within 5 seconds, the channel changes by 1 in the appropriate direction.

\* The TV can receive channels 1 through 62.

\* If the UP button is pressed on channel 62, the TV changes to channel 1, If the DOWN button is pressed on channel 62.

## 2. Auto tuning

While the channel is displayed, press and hold either the UP or DOWN button to perform auto tuning. The TV will automatically stop at the next channel it can receive.

continue using the auto tuning function after a channel has been received, press and hold the UP or To continue using the auto tuning function after a channel has been received, press and note the <u>DP</u> or <u>DOWN</u> button again within 5 seconds.
 If no channels can be received during auto tuning, the auto tuning function will come to a stop after cycling through all channels (1 through 62).

\* Tuning Mode changes back to time display if no buttons are pressed within 5 seconds after the tuning function has come to a stop.

## **Cautions Regarding Broadcast Signals** and the TV Display

\* The earphone on this product acts as the antenna for receiving broadcast signals.

If you wind the earphone antenna up while using it, it will not be able to receive broadcast signals. If the video becomes unclear, you should try straightening the earphone antenna cord, or changing the direction in which the product is facing.

\* Reception may be adversely affected or completely prevented due to long distance from broadcast stations, proximity to buildings or mountains, underground areas, and other locations. As a result, video and audio may not be clear.

\* While traveling in a car, on a train, or other means of transportation, the TV may have difficulty receiving broadcast signals. As a result, video and audio may not be


\* The TV display may be difficult to see on days when the sunlight is particularly

## Adjusting the volume

The volume can be adjusted when time is displayed or the volume indicator is on.

- 1. Press and hold either the UP or DOWN button.
- 2. The volume indicator is displayed on the clock LCD. Press either the UP button (to increase volume) or the DOWN button (to decrease volume). You can press and hold either button for rapid
- \* If the volume is not adjusted within 5 seconds after the volume indicator is displayed, the LCD returns to the clock display. However, the volume indicator will continue to be displayed as long as a button is pressed and held

## Setting the date and time

#### Setting the date and time

The date and time are set while the TV is turned off.

- 1. First, set the date. Press and hold the SET button.
- 2. The "Year" display flashes. Press the UP and DOWN buttons to set the correct year, and the press the SET button.

3. Next, set the month. Follow the same procedure as above to set the month and day.

4. Next, set the time. Follow the same procedure as above to set the time.

To view the date, press the SET button while the TV is off. The date is displayed for \* approximately 3 seconds, and then the display automatically returns to the watch

When the setting is complete, the colon (:) begins to flash. If the colon does not flash, \* the watch has not been set. Perform the setting procedure again from the start.


## Resetting the unit

If the TV does not respond when the buttons are pressed, or if the watch is not displayed, press and hold the UP and DOWN buttons simultaneously.

After the unit is reset, the date and time will return to their default values. These settings will need to be made again.

## Removing the unit from the wristband

1. Insert your fingernail in the edge of the holding clip where the unit is connected to the wristband.



- 2. With your fingernail in the slot, lift the unit.
  - \* Be careful not to pull too strongly on the unit. Doing so could damage it.



3. Arrow 1: Insert the TV unit into the wristband-docking unit until the clip is landed on the TV unit slot.

Arrow 2: Bring the TV unit down to the wristbanddocking unit until it clips in the slot and is completely locked to the wristband-docking unit.




## Recharging the internal battery

[Items used: TV unit + AC adapter + external battery case]


\* Use the same procedure to watch the TV using the AC adapter.

 Insert the plug from the AC adapter into the DC input terminal.



 Pull out the DC connection cable and clip it into the anchoring rib as shown in the figures.





Anchoring Rib

Press the anchoring clip on one side to unclip to open it while installing the TV unit.

Arrow 1: Dock first the lower side of the TV unit to land it onto the AC adapter case.

Arrow 2: Doc the upper side of the TV unit to perfectly clip it onto the AC adapter case.




\*Be careful when installing the unit, to prevent damaging it.

4.Plug the **DC connection** cable into the DC input terminal on the TV unit.

The LED lamp stays on while the battery is recharging, and goes off when recharging is complete.

When the TV unit is on and at the time it is docked to the AC adapter, the LED lamp is turned on.

5.Connect the electric AC adapter plug into the external battery case unit.




## Cautions when using the external battery case

- \* Do not place batteries in the external battery case while recharging the internal TV unit battery or while watching TV by using the AC adapter.
- \* You can not recharge the internal battery while watching the TV.
- \* You can not recharge any rechargeable batteries by placing them in the external battery case and connecting the AC adapter.
- \* Alkaline batteries are recommended when using batteries in the external battery case. Although the rechargeable batteries can be used, they may not satisfy the unit's power requirements. No other types of batteries should be used.


## Using batteries to watch TV


[Items used: TV unit + external battery case + batteries]
Use 4 AA alkaline batteries.

- 1. Press the battery lid in the direction of Arrow 1 in the figure.
- 2. Slide the battery lid in the direction of Arrow 2.




Place the AA batteries inside, being careful that they are facing in the correct directions.





Install the TV unit on the external battery case, and then insert the DC connection cable into the DC input terminal on the TV unit.



\* If the internal battery is dead, it will be recharged by the batteries in the external battery case. (Approximately 90 minutes is required for recharging.)

## **Troubleshooting**

If you believe the unit is malfunctioning, try the following inspections.
