

# Sony FDL-220R Watchman Speaker Replacement

A bad mono-speaker can lead to distorted or no audio on the Sony FDL-220R Watchman. This guide will show you how to replace the mono speaker in order to fix the device's sound.

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide will outline how to replace the Sony FDL-220R Watchman mono-speaker. Steps include a thorough disassembly of the Sony FDL-220R Watchman, and tools include a Phillips #00 Screwdriver, soldering station, and tweezers.

Knowledge of how to solder a basic through-hole contact is required.



### **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)
- Soldering Iron (1)

## Step 1 — Remove battery cover and batteries





- Press down on the textured area and push toward the bottom of the device.
- Gently remove the battery cover.
- Remove the three AA batteries.


## Step 2 — Remove screws






- Locate the five 5x11mm screws surrounding the battery compartment.
- Remove screws with a Phillips #00 screwdriver.


## Step 3 — Remove back casing






- Grasp the entire back half of the Watchman's casing.
- Snap off the casing from the bottom of the device.
- Gently pull off entire back casing.
- (i) Buttons may fall out upon opening casing. See the <u>button replacement guide</u> to fix buttons.

## Step 4 — Remove circuit board







- Carefully grasp the entire circuit board.
- Pull the circuit board off of the device's plastic casing.

### Step 5 — Remove speaker







- Locate the mono-speaker on the device.
- Locate the two through-hole contacts to the right of the speaker.
- Touch a soldering iron to the two through-hole contacts.
- While the solder is hot, pull down on the wire with tweezers.
- (i) It may be helpful to remove excess solder with a solder wick or sucker.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
